# American Life League's Report on Planned Parenthood Facilities for 2007

## Abstract

*Objectives* – This report represents data on the locations of Planned Parenthood clinic facilities across the United States. The locations are identified by the types of services they provide, with particular note given to those that are identified by Planned Parenthood as express clinics.

*Methods* – The data was collected from a variety of resources. The researchers used the national web site of Planned Parenthood Federation of America as well as web sites of local Planned Parenthood affiliates. In addition, information was received from individuals and organizations across the country. Where any questions arose or any of the data sources gave conflicting information, phone calls were made to individual Planned Parenthood clinic sites to determine the accurate data.

*Completion date* – It is recognized that the status of Planned Parenthood facilities is a fluid one. New clinics open, old clinics close and specific services at facilities change on a regular basis. Hence, this report is a snapshot at a point in time. The data collection efforts were completed on December 5, 2007 and the data in this report reflects the situation as of that day.

*Results* – Planned Parenthood continues to close more clinics than it opens. Our survey shows that Planned Parenthood operates a total of 855 clinics, down from the 859 last year. Of those, 41 are express clinics (no physical exams performed) and the remaining 814 are non-express clinics. It was clear that Planned Parenthood was very aggressive in opening new facilities in 2007. We added a total of 25 clinic sites in 15 states to our list. Although some of these sites are full-blown clinics that commit surgical abortions (e.g., Aurora, Illinois), others are one-day-a-week operations located in places like county health department buildings. A total of 21 Planned Parenthood clinics are now open only one day a week. It is also clear that people across the country are working hard to close down Planned Parenthood facilities by spreading the truth about the organization and convincing people not to patronize the clinics, and governments not to fund Planned Parenthood's operations. We removed 29 clinic sites in 15 states from the list of Planned Parenthood facilities. Planned Parenthood's chain of medical and surgical abortion facilities grew to a total of 287 facilities that perform surgical or medical abortions. This is an increase of 55 from last year. Forty-eight of those 55 additional locations are medical abortion facilities. We identified 179 Planned Parenthood facilities that commit surgical abortions and another 108 that do medical abortions (but not surgical). Our survey shows Planned Parenthood currently has a total of 108 affiliates across the country, down from the 117 it had last year. Planned Parenthood continues to merge affiliates to cut costs and increase its overall profits.

## Introduction

The Planned Parenthood Federation of America is the largest and richest affiliate of the International Planned Parenthood Federation. PPFA is comprised of a number of affiliates within the United States. Each of these affiliates operates a number of facilities that dispense contraception and commit abortions. Each year, American Life League conducts a nationwide survey to determine the exact number and type of facilities operated by each of the PPFA affiliates.

**Types of abortions:** The following definitions were used to classify the types of abortions performed at the various Planned Parenthood locations:

- Surgical abortions are those that involve an invasive procedure – vacuum aspiration, dilation and curettage, dilation and evacuation, saline, etc.
- Medical abortions are those that involve the administration of a drug – Mifepristone, Methotrexate, etc.
- Chemical abortions are caused by those products that work, at least some of the time, by preventing an already created human being from implanting in the uterine lining – the birth control pill, the birth control patch, injectables, etc.

**Types of PP facilities:** Planned Parenthood operates a number of different types of facilities across the country. The following types are of special interest to American Life League and we report specifically on them:

- Clinics that commit chemical abortions by selling birth control products that work a percentage of the time by preventing implantation of an already created human being. These are designated as “C” facilities.
- Clinics that commit chemical and medical abortions (using products like Mifepristone to kill babies after implantation) but not surgical ones. These are designated as “MC” facilities.
- Clinics that commit chemical, medical and surgical abortions. These are designated as “SMC” facilities.
- Express clinics that provide limited expedited services. Planned Parenthood says, "At an express health center, clients who are short on time and do not require a table examination can quickly pick up their birth control medication or get contraceptive advice."

**Caveat:** The data used in this survey come from a variety of sources, including, but not limited to, printed Planned Parenthood material, Planned Parenthood internet postings and reports from individuals around the country. Planned Parenthood is a large, complex business and its clinic numbers and locations are continually changing. This survey is conducted over a 90-day period and the results are accurate to the best of our ability on the date indicated.

## Results

Key findings, which are illustrated in Charts 1-3 and Tables 1-3:

- The data show that Planned Parenthood currently has 108 affiliates across the United States operating medical facilities in 49 states plus the District of Columbia. It has only an educational office in North Dakota. The 108 affiliates represent a decline of 9 affiliates since last year and an overall loss of 73 affiliate groups since 1987. Figure 1 shows the number of affiliates through the years. Reduction of affiliates is accomplished by merging affiliates together. It results in increased efficiencies for the federation and a reduction of costs by eliminating duplicate top staff

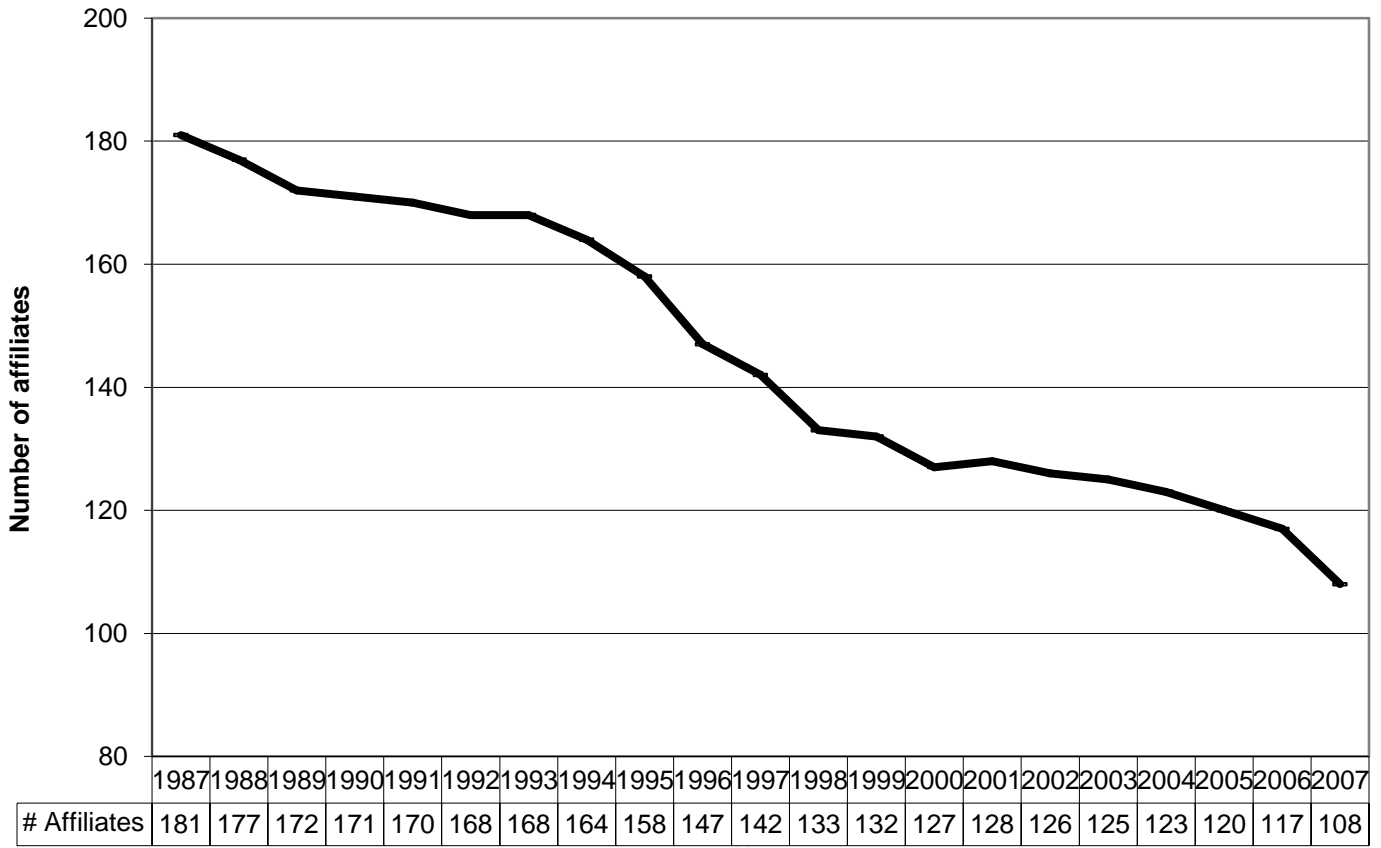
positions. This year's affiliate reduction is the largest since it eliminated nine affiliates in 1998 and 11 in 1996.

- The total number of Planned Parenthood medical facilities showed a modest decline of four since last year. The total number stands at 855. This is the fifth straight year that the total number of Planned Parenthood clinics has declined. The data shows that 41 of the clinics were express clinics that provide no physical exams. These express clinics began opening in 2003 and last year Planned Parenthood had 42 clinics that we classified as express.
- Planned Parenthood has 814 non-express clinics, a decline of three since last year. Non-express clinics have fallen by 124 since 1995. Figure 2 shows the number of Planned Parenthood clinics by year since 1987. The number of non-express clinics is at the lowest it has been since it had 791 such clinics in 1986.
- As is shown by the data in Table 1, the distribution of Planned Parenthood clinics across the country continues to have a three-tier formulation.
  - The top tier contains states having more than 75 clinics. Three states – California (100), Texas (79) and New York (78) – comprise this tier and have 30% (257) of all Planned Parenthood clinics in the country.
  - The second tier is comprised of those states that have between 25 and 50 clinics. There are 12 states that fall in this category and account for 44% (375) of PP's clinics. These states include Washington (46), Pennsylvania (44), Ohio (36), Indiana (35), Wisconsin (30), Michigan (29), New Jersey (29), Florida (26), Colorado (25), Iowa (25), Minnesota (25) and Illinois (25).
  - The remaining 34 states (there are zero clinics in North Dakota) have only 26% (223) of all the Planned Parenthood clinics. Twenty-one of those states, and the District of Columbia, have five or less clinics.
- Planned Parenthood continues to run the largest abortion chain in the nation with a total of 287 surgical and/or medical abortion facilities. Surgical abortions are performed at 179 of its facilities while an additional 108 facilities do medical abortions, but not surgical. Tables 2 and 3 list the locations of these facilities.
  - Of Planned Parenthood surgical and medical abortion facilities, 27 percent (78) are in California, 16 percent (45) are in New York state and 9 percent (26) are in Washington state.
  - Planned Parenthood does not have any surgical or medical abortion facilities in Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, Nevada, North Dakota, Utah, West Virginia or Wyoming.

Due to the extensive list of Planned Parenthood locations (855), we have not printed the list as part of this report. A nationwide map is presented in Figure 3 and the location of each Planned Parenthood facility, their services and other information, can be found at [www.all.org/stopp/maps](http://www.all.org/stopp/maps)

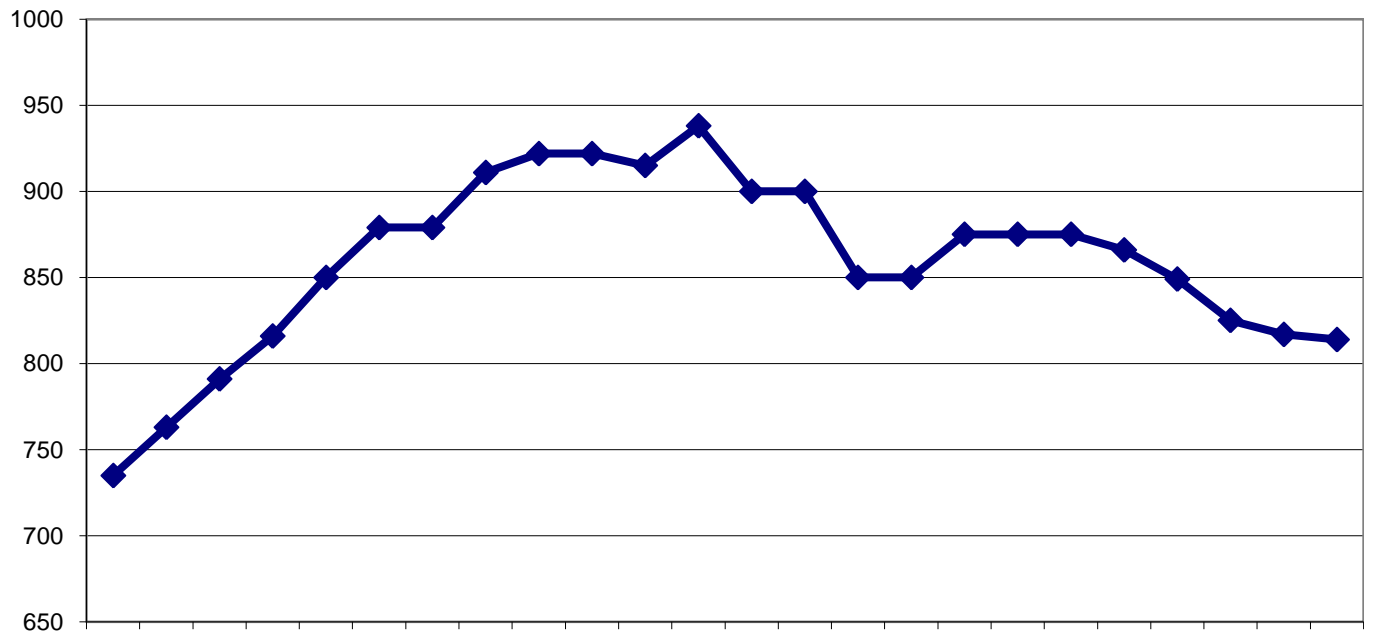
**Figure #1: Number of Planned Parenthood Federation of America affiliates in the United States by calendar year**

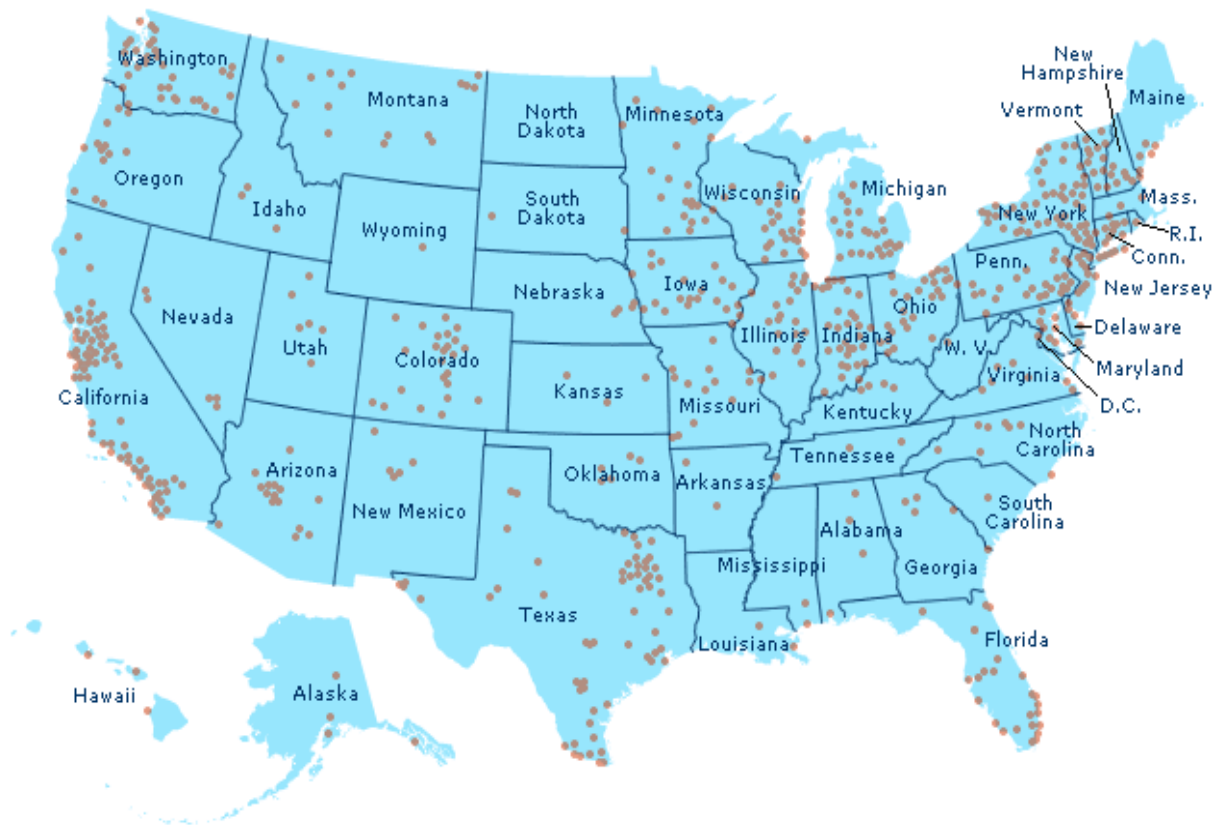
