

2013 Survey of Planned Parenthood Facilities

Planned Parenthood Federation of America, through its affiliates, operates facilities (clinics) in the United States that provide limited medical services. Each year, American Life League's Stop Planned Parenthood International (STOPP) project does a count of those PPFA facilities and determines their location and what kinds of abortions are committed at each one. This report presents data on the number of the facilities and type of services and procedures they offer as of December 30, 2013.

SUMMARY: Eighth straight year of decline in both total facilities and affiliates

Facilities – Measuring by number of facilities, Planned Parenthood Federation of America closed 48 clinics while opening 13, marking the eighth straight year of facility decline. Planned Parenthood is now reporting a total of 695 clinics, which is the lowest number of facilities reported since 1973.

Fifteen states have fewer Planned Parenthood facilities than reported last year, while only three have increased from last year's totals. The physical location of each clinic is available online at the STOPP Map Room (www.stopp.org/maproom.php).

Abortion – The percentage of Planned Parenthood clinics committing surgical and/or medical abortion increased from 47 percent in 2012 to 49 percent in 2013. In 2013, PPFA reported 342 facilities committing surgical and/or medical abortions. Of those, 170 facilities offered both surgical and medical abortion, while 168 offered medical abortions, but not surgical. Four clinics reported offering only surgical abortions.

METHODOLOGY: One physical address = one facility

Methods – Researchers collected data from the national website of Planned Parenthood Federation of America, the websites of local Planned Parenthood affiliates, and from individuals and organizations across the country. Where any discrepancy arose between data sources, phone calls were made to individual Planned Parenthood clinic sites to determine the accurate data.

Clinic count – Researchers encountered a number of locations where Planned Parenthood claimed more than one clinic at the same physical address. This most frequently happened when PP was separating its abortion business from the rest of its services. In all cases where more than one clinic was listed at the same physical address, it was counted as one clinic.

Data collection period – The status of Planned Parenthood facilities is a fluid one. New clinics open, old clinics close, and specific services at facilities change on a regular basis. The data collection efforts were done over a 90-day period and were completed on December 30, 2013. Hence, this report reflects the situation as of that day.

DISCUSSION:

For the first time since 1973, Planned Parenthood is operating less than 700 facilities. Whether measured by number of facilities or total affiliates, 2013 marked the eighth straight year of decline for Planned Parenthood.

This decline cannot be attributed to the actions of one particular state or region, as Planned Parenthood closed facilities in 16 states. Planned Parenthood’s number of affiliates decreased from 74 in 2012 to 71 in 2013, continuing the trend of massive consolidation in management since the high point of 191 Planned Parenthood affiliates in 1978.

Planned Parenthood most frequently cited pressure from legislation, be it defunding efforts or laws tightening clinic standards, as the main reason for facility closings. In states where legislative pressure was not felt, Planned Parenthood most frequently reported facility closures due to a dwindling customer base and an effort to consolidate facilities nearer to its core demographic. In 2013, 79 percent of the facilities closed were contraceptive-only facilities.

Planned Parenthood’s rebranding efforts in the face of a growing public awareness of its activities continued in full force throughout 2013. Planned Parenthood looks to be positioning itself to obtain new streams of federal and state revenue available due to the implementation of the Affordable Care Act. Without such funding, Planned Parenthood has shown itself to be incapable of survival.

Table 1 – Planned Parenthood Clinics and Affiliates by Year

Planned Parenthood Federation of America has its national headquarters in New York City, and is comprised of separately incorporated affiliates across the country. Each affiliate must adhere to standards of affiliation as created by the national office, pay dues to the national office (approximately one percent of its gross income), and participate in nationwide insurance and volume purchasing agreements.

The national office does not operate any clinics. All clinics are operated by the affiliates. The table below shows, by year, the number of affiliates and the total number of clinics operated by Planned Parenthood in the 50 states and District of Columbia. Numbers prior to 2003 are taken directly from PPFA annual reports. Beginning in 2003, numbers are from our own surveys.

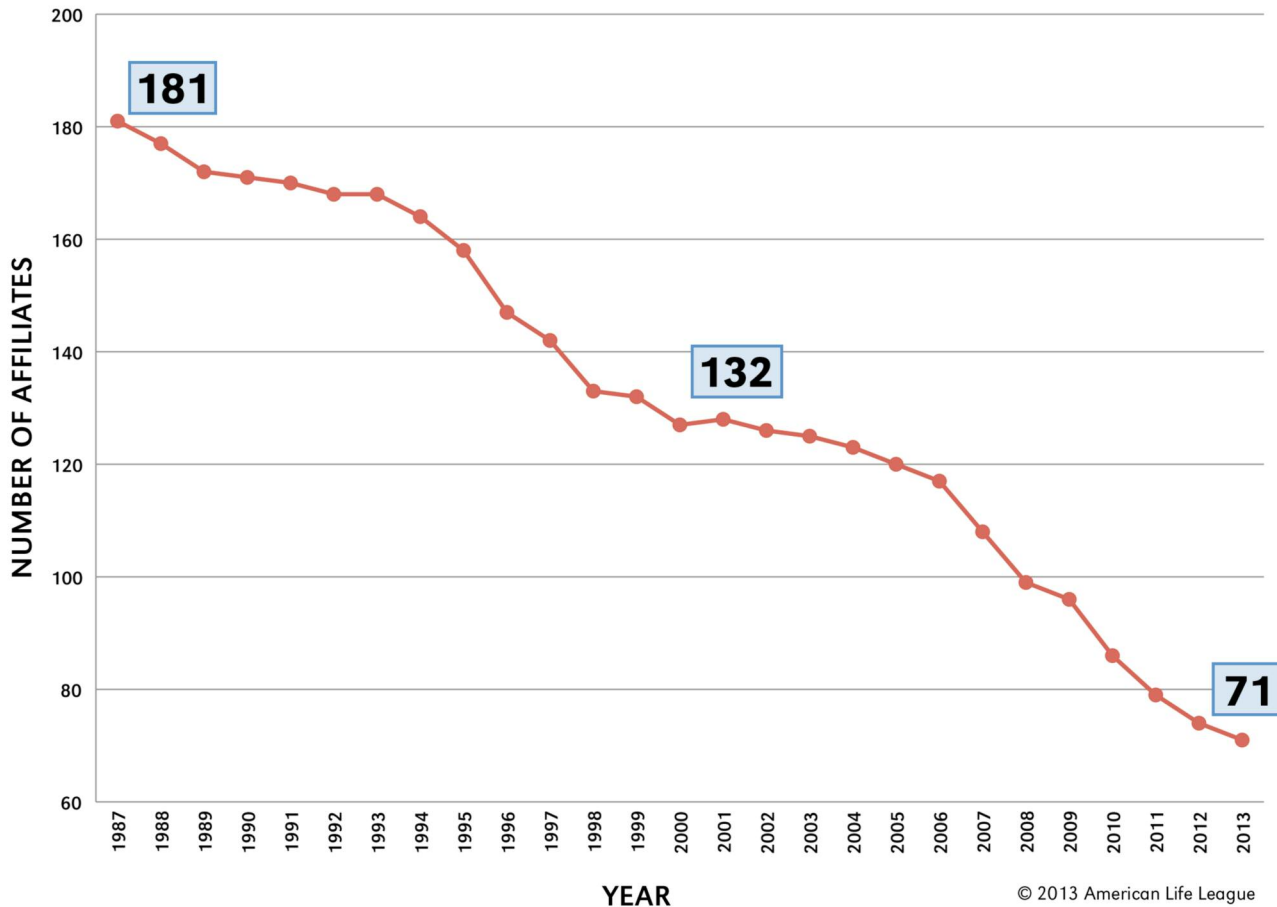


Table 2 – PPFA Surgical and Medical Abortion Facilities

There are three types of abortions routinely offered at Planned Parenthood facilities across the country: surgical, medical, and contraceptive. These types are defined as:

Surgical abortions – abortions that are performed with various types of instruments or invasive procedures to enter the mother’s uterus and directly kill the human being. Under current United States law, these abortions can occur at any time while the human being is, at least partially, in the womb.

Medical abortions – abortions caused by administering a drug to the woman up to seven weeks after implantation to end the life of a human being in the womb. There are a number of drugs used including mifepristone, methotrexate, and misoprostol. Many people still refer to these drugs by the research name RU-486.

Contraceptive abortions – drugs or devices that end the life of a human being in the womb by failing to prevent fertilization but preventing implantation. So-called “contraceptive” products do not always prevent fertilization. Rather, pharmaceutical literature confirms that when these drugs fail to prevent the creation of a new life, they still make the mother’s uterus hostile to implantation which results in the death of the living human embryo. Products sold by Planned Parenthood which produce these abortion outcomes include the morning-after pill, the low dose and mini oral contraceptives, the patch, the injectables, and others.

Percent of Planned Parenthood Clinics by Type of Abortion

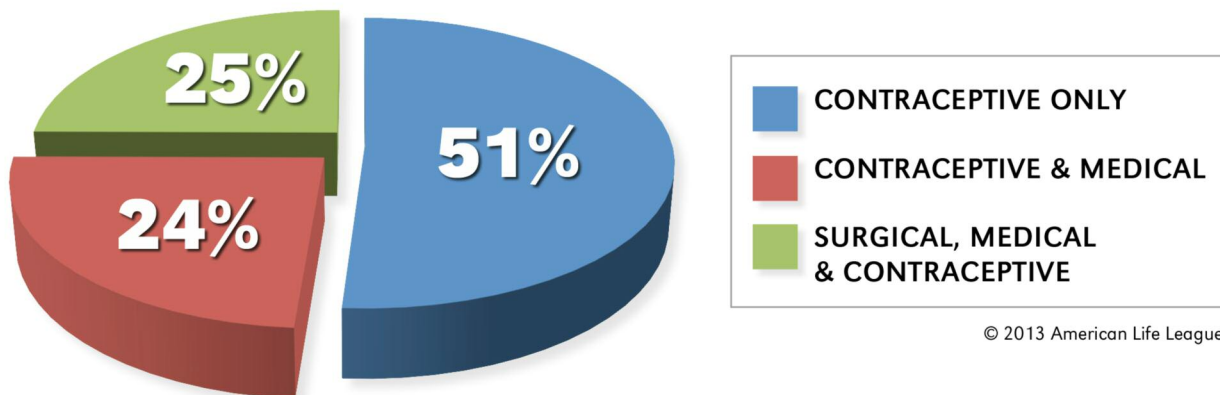
